The Concerto Competition is an integral part of ANAM's performance training. The annual event begins in Semester One where interested musicians are asked to record a 20-minute excerpt of a concerto, or other substantial work for soloist and orchestra.

This year, thirty-seven ANAM musicians submitted recordings with piano accompaniment, with twelve progressing to the second round. Over the next two days, three finalists will be chosen to progress to the final round on October 8, where they will perform their concerti with the Tasmanian Symphony Orchestra (TSO) and conductor Johannes Fritzsch at the Federation Concert Hall, Hobart.
