

## **Essential checklist for applicants applying for a place at the Australian National Academy of Music in 2017**

To secure your place in the Australian National Academy of Music's 2016 Professional Performance Program all applicants are required to apply using ANAM's online application system- accessed through the [ANAM Website](#)

ANAM's online application system does not allow applicants to save and return to the application once you have commenced the online process. To ensure your session does not time out please have the following documents at the ready as well as a credit or debit card to process the \$90 application fee.

What you need to apply:

- **Current Curriculum Vitae including the following information**
  1. Your Chamber Music performance experience
  2. Your Orchestral experience, if applicable
  3. Major works performed in the past five years
  4. Any prizes, bursaries and scholarships you have been awarded
  5. Details of any additional instruments studied and to what level
- **Academic Transcripts and qualification**

A copy of your academic transcripts and qualifications. If completing a degree in the year of application, please include your transcripts of results to date.
- **Photographic identification**

Photo must be in passport or headshot format
- **300-word personal statement**

Please provide a 300-word summary articulating your immediate to long-term artistic goals, and how ANAM is relevant in realising these objectives. It is also required of you to provide a detailed outline of your anticipated or pre-existing professional affiliations over the next 12 months.
- **All documents must be saved in .PDF format**
- **All documents file names must be saved with your name and instrument in the following format:**

EG. 1 SURNAME\_FIRSTNAME\_INSTRUMENT CV.pdf  
EG. 2 SURNAME\_FIRSTNAME\_INSTRUMENT Transcript.pdf
- **NB: Applicants born **before Dec 31 1988** are *ineligible* to apply to the 2017 ANAM Professional Performance Program and the 2016 ANAM/Griffith Master of Music (Research)**
